



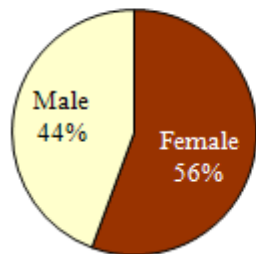

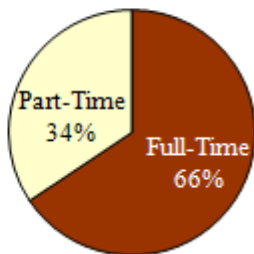

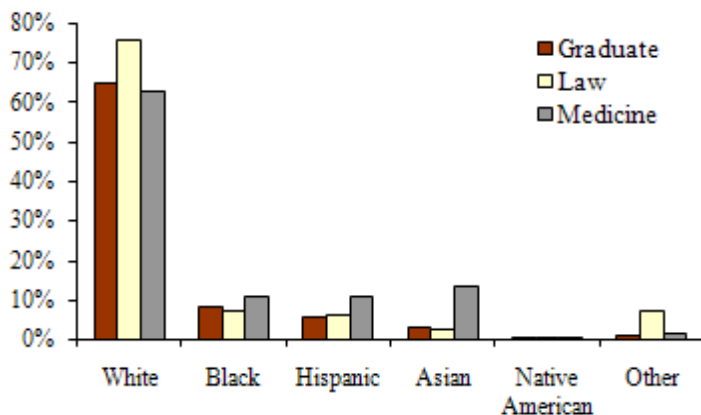
#### GENDER



#### FULL-TIME/ PART-TIME

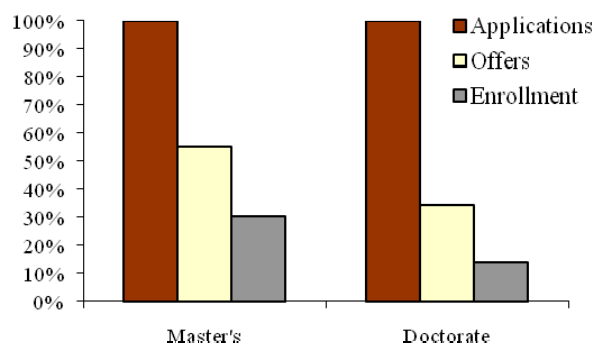


#### RACE AND ETHNICITY OF STUDENT

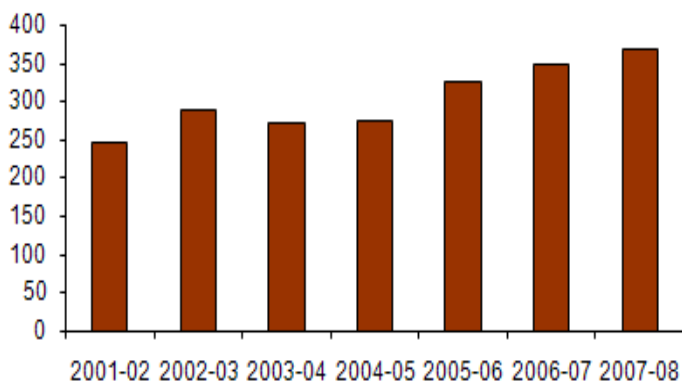
